For your health -A test can save your life! You have questions about your sexual health? You want to know more about HIV/Aids?

Medicines of today have developed so far that it is now possible to treat and even cure many diseases that were previously untreatable.

An infection with HIV does not necessarily mean that one will get Aids and die.

There is only one way to know ones status:

to get tested.

If someone is positively tested with HIV, it is possible for them to get an effective therapy to avoid the outbreak of Aids. Thank to this therapy it is now possible for HIV positive persons to have a normal and healthy life, and avoid the transmission of the virus to their children. Moreover if one knows their status, they will avoid infecting their partner unintentionally, but can protect them.

DO YOU KNOW THAT ...?:



A non-treated HIV infection can lead to the deadly disease Aids.



One cannot see if someone is HIV positive. HIV positive persons don't look always sick and can live years without symptoms.



Everyone can get HIV, regardless of their age, sexual orientation, gender or ethnic origin!

HIV CAN BE TRANSMITTED BY:



Unprotected sexual intercourses with a man or a woman. Condoms protect from HIV and other sexual transmissible infections (STI).



Sharing needles (for example by injecting drugs or being tattooed without sterile needles).



If a mother is HIV positive and is not taking the HIV-therapy, the virus can be transmitted to the baby (during pregnancy, during birth or by breastfeeding).

HIV CAN NOT BE TRANSMITTED BY:



Everyday interactions with HIV positive persons (living, working together, sharing a bathroom or toilets...).



Eating or drinking from the same tableware.



Kissing, hugging or caressing someone.

HIV tests and counselling sessions are FREE in public health offices (Gesundheitsämter) and at the Aids-Hilfen. You don't need a HEALTH **INSURANCE ID** (medical referral).



You don't have to give your names or address: tests and counselling are ANONYMOUS.



The test result and the counselling sessions are CONFIDENTIAL. You are the only person who will be spoken to. Important: nobody will be displaced only because of an HIV-Infection!



If you have questions or you think that you might have been infected, you are always welcome at any of these counselling points. Together we can find solutions!

How to protect yourself and the others from infections?



Condoms are a really good solution to protect you and your partner(s) from HIV, STI and unwanted pregnancy. You can get free condoms in the counselling offices and at the Aids-Hilfe.



It is really important to speak regularly to your partner about your health. If you notice any infections or if you have doubts, don't hesitate to talk to her or him! It is also the first step in protecting them!

A visit to the doctor



Doctors are obliged to medical secrecy. They are not allowed to talk about their patients with external parties (even public authorities or police), unless the patients gave them the authorisation to do so. They are also neutral and won't judge or discriminate against you in anyhow as a person or for your acts.

If the medical secrecy is broken, or if you are discriminated against, you can contact the Aids-Hilfe or local counselling offices for refugees to get help.

Your doctor is in any case your most important partner for your health. Don't hesitate to talk with him or her about your sexual health, particularly if you had a risk situation and even if they are no obvious symptom yet.



If you find it difficult to speak about HIV/Aids or sexual health with your doctor, you can use this note. Tick the appropriate cases for you and give this flyer to your doctor. They know the best how
